# Hampton Beach Summer Mission

*a Cru Summer Mission since 1973*



## THE PROGRAM

Students spend 10 weeks employed in the local communities of Hampton Beach. They participate in small group Bible studies, men's and women's times, one-on-one discipleship, ministry training, church service, and servant teams of their choosing to utilize their strengths for God's glory. At the midpoint of the summer, students take on leadership roles which equip them for a lifetime of relying on God, serving others, sharing their faith, and taking the initiative. Each student comes as a member but leaves as a leader.



## LODGING

Students stay in a newly renovated beach home that's a two minute walk to the beach. In 2011, the mission was in its final year due to a loss of housing contract. As members packed and sold furniture, Dave MacArthur, a local church member, walked by and was saddened to see HBSM end. Having come to faith through mission students in 1973, Dave and his wife Amy prayed about providing a new home so that the mission could continue. The following year, the MacArthurs purchased the historic property at 20G Street. It needed a lot of work, so the whole MacArthur family rolled up their sleeves, renovated in the off season, and opened their new doors to the next class of HBSM students without missing a year. Each winter the MacArthurs add more to their labor of love, like wood floors, fully equipped kitchens, a beautiful covered porch, and new beds with protective-sealed mattresses. The common room is lined with photos of past missions through the decades. Students have come to love this house and think of it as a second home.
